Personal Interview

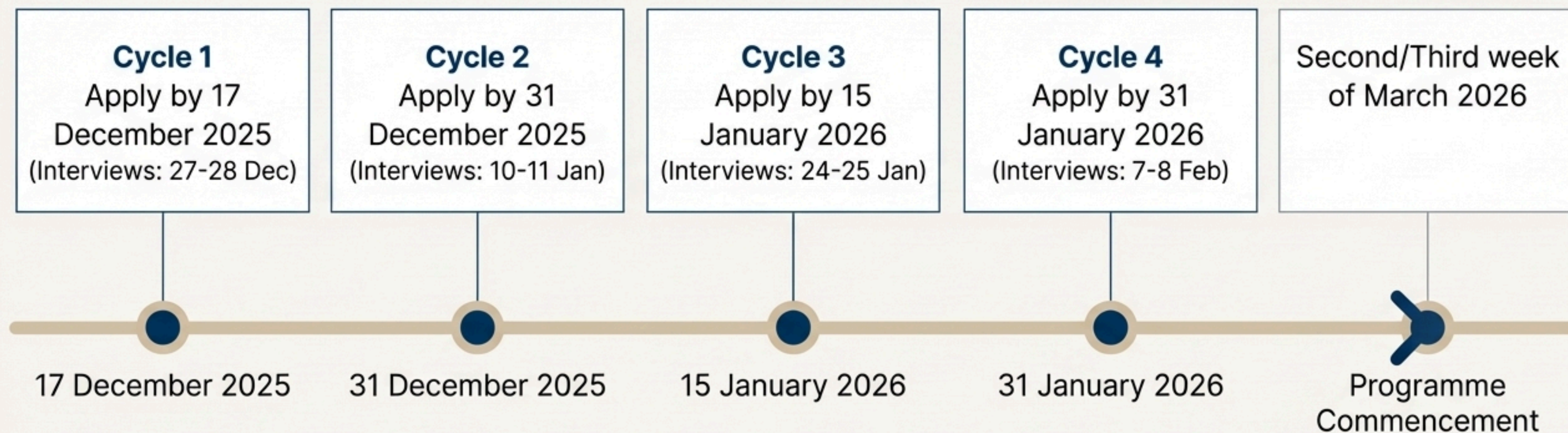
Shortlisted candidates will be invited to an online personal interview.
