Re: Audit of Placement Report for the batch 2021-23 of Master of Business Administration

We have audited the data related to remuneration, function & location as presented in the Placement Report prepared by IIM Bodh Gaya for the final placement (based on the offers received and accepted on campus) for the batch of Master of Business Administration of Indian Institute of Management Bodh Gaya (IIM Bodh Gaya) for 2021-23.

The preparation of the Placement Report is the responsibility of IIM Bodh Gaya. Our responsibility is to validate the information related to remuneration, function & location provided in the report with the relevant documentation and comment on the conformance of those with the Indian Placement Reporting Standards (IPRS) Revision 2.2.

In this context, we confirm the following:

1. For the purpose of the audit, we have obtained all the information and explanations, which, to the best of our knowledge and belief, were necessary. In our opinion, the data related to remuneration, function & location as presented in the Placement Report complies with the Indian Placement Reporting Standards Revision 2.2.
2. The validation of information presented in the report is based on communication received by IIM Bodh Gaya from recruiting companies. Brickworks Analytics (BWA) has not independently sourced any information or documentation from the recruiters.
3. We have verified the information with respect to job location, function and remuneration presented in the report with communication received from recruiters by IIM Bodh Gaya.

- a. The information has been categorised as best as possible under different salary heads as given in the IPRS Revision 2.2; where a break-up was not available, the salary has been considered only as 'Maximum Earning Potential'.
 - b. The data points mentioned under different salary heads are representative of aggregate salary components offered to the candidates.
 - c. Stock Options/RSUs have been mentioned for some students with details on the amount to be vested in the first year. Hence, the corresponding amount has been considered for the calculation of the 'Maximum Earning Potential'.
 - d. Long-Term benefits like ESOPs (vested after the first year), retention bonus and any other long-term benefit to be paid after the first year have not been considered for the calculation of 'Maximum Earning Potential'.
 - e. We have considered the amount of gratuity in the calculation of MEP, as has been considered by the recruiters in their offers, even though it is payable after 5 years of continuous service, as this amount was not separately available for all the candidates.
 - f. We could not verify the location for some students as some recruiting companies do not mention it in the offer letter or the location is decided after joining. These students have been put under the 'to be disclosed' category.
 - g. Wherever information was missing reasonable assumptions have been made.
4. The acceptance of offers and the number of students opting out of the placement process has been established through written communication by IIM Bodh Gaya.
5. We have only audited the data related to remuneration, function & location (Pg. nos. 7 to 16) in the Placement report and not the placement highlights section or any additional information presented in the report.

Career Development Cell of the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Bodh Gaya is extremely delighted to share the exceptional final placement achievement for the MBA Batch 2021-23. Once again, we have surpassed industry expectations, cementing our position as a budding leader in management education.

For a graduating batch of 207 students, the Institute witnessed active participation from 84 esteemed companies spanning across diverse sectors like BFSI, FMCG, ITES & Analytics, Manufacturing & Logistics, eCommerce, and Education at large. The highest domestic package offered to the batch stood at INR 48.58 LPA registering a growth of 104% vis a vis the previous batch. Similarly, the Institute registered exceptional growth in its median and average domestic packages, which stood at 16.00 LPA and 14.96 LPA, recording a stupendous growth of 37% and 25%, respectively, YoY.

The major recruiters in the Consulting and Analytics space were Deloitte US, Tiger Analytics, Kantar Analytics Practice, Kore.ai Software, Factspan Analytics, Brillio, CRISIL, and Accelalpha. The major IT & Services players included the likes of Sutherland Global, Bharti Airtel, Cognizant Technology Solutions, Trinamix Inc, HCL Tech, iQuanti India, Infosys BPM, Zycus, Adobe Inc., Affinity, DemandFarm, Park+, to name a few. In line with the substantial post-pandemic demand revival, sectors like metals & mining, manufacturing, logistics, and automotive were next in the queue offering more than 30 opportunities. The notable names were Adani Group, ArcelorMittal Nippon Steel India, Hindalco Industries Limited, Mercedes-Benz, Crompton Greaves Consumer Electricals Limited, Ultratech Cement, Maruti Suzuki India Limited, Volvo Eicher Commercial Vehicles Limited, Porter and DTDC. The Institute also witnessed decent participation from e-commerce, FMCG, and market research firms like Amazon India, Bluestone, Haldirams, Reliance Retail, and MoEngage.

To ensure the accuracy and reliability of Placement Reports, the Institute has introduced auditing of Placement Reports since last year. This initiative aims to empower aspiring professionals and students, enabling them to make well-informed decisions while considering IIM Bodh Gaya as their preferred destination.

I congratulate MBA Batch 2021-23 for showcasing their remarkable academic and non-scholastic distinctions. 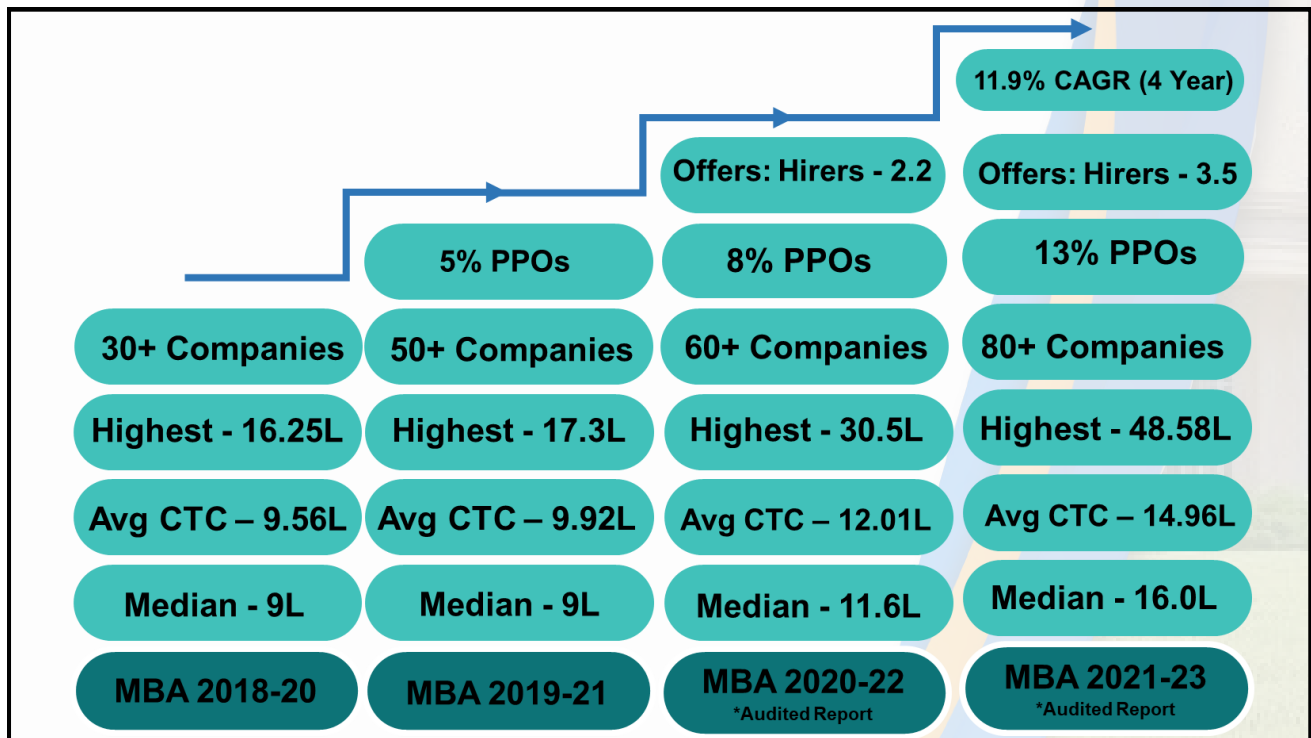
