Type II: Waitlist EoI: Candidates will be in wait-list after depositing EoI, and offers will be made on vacant seat basis.

Type III: Cleared sectional Cut-off, but not in Waitlist EoI as on date: Candidates will be considered for Waitlist EoI in the later stage if required.

Type IV: Not cleared the sectional cut-off, will not be considered.

Offers for further SNG will be sent in the next list based on the number of girls in the main pool.

Students (Type I) will be asked to confirm the WL EoI by depositing INR 12,500 in the IIM Bodh Gaya account (through <u>SBI collect</u>) till 1st **July 2023**. Further, they will be asked to deposit the remaining amount in two parts INR 60,000 and INR 1,80,000.

Students (Type II) will be asked to confirm the WL EoI by depositing INR 12,500 in IIM Bodh Gaya account (through SBI collect) till 1st July 2023. The WL number will be shared with them on 3rd July 2023. The Provisional Admission Offer (students of Type I) will be shared on the basis of the vacant seats.

For the remaining candidates (Type III), the waitlist-EoI will be decided in the future list, if required.

Candidates are advised to verify the fulfilment of the following eligibility criteria for admission into the IPM 2023-25 batch.

Qualifying Exam: Candidates should have passed 10+2/XII/HSC examination in arts/commerce/science stream or equivalent with 60% (55% for candidates from SC/ST/PwD/Transgender) or more in the year 2022 or appearing in 2023. Candidates who are likely to complete standard XII/ HSC or equivalent by 31 July 2023 can also apply. The candidate must have passed the class 10th examination with 60% (55% for candidates from SC/ST/PwD/Transgender) or more in the year not before 2020.

The percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in Class X and Class XII would be calculated based on the Board's regulation. If there is no such regulation regarding aggregate marks from the concerned board, then the aggregate marks of all the subjects that appear in the grade sheet should be considered for calculating the passing percentage.

The application of the candidates, who are appearing in Class XII examination, will be provisional till their Class XII result. The candidates who do not score the requisite score as above will be considered to be out of the application/admission process.

Admission to the programme is open to Indian citizens only.
