Ph.D. CHAIRPERSON'S MESSAGE

The Doctoral (Ph.D.) Programme of the Indian Institute of Management Bodh Gaya was launched in 2020 and offers a number of specialties in management and allied fields. The programme is looking for students who are incredibly driven and dedicated and have the capability of doing demanding multidisciplinary research. The programme's objective is to prepare committed scholars for careers as experts in their areas of research-based inquiry as well as for careers as outstanding management educators. IIM Bodh Gaya being one of the third generation IIMs to be set up in India in 2015, offers its Ph.D. programme across eight different groups of specialization such as Marketing, Economics, Finance and Accounting, Information Technology Systems and Analytics, Organization Behaviour and Human Resource Management, Humanity and Liberal Arts (Business Communication), Operations Management & Quantitative Techniques and Strategy and Entrepreneurship. Ph.D. candidates at IIM Bodh Gaya have the academic freedom to develop their own research focus and collaborate closely with academics of their choice. All Ph.D. students must complete demanding coursework over the first two years in order to equip themselves with the fundamental management knowledge and abilities that are required to become autonomous researchers. In the second year, students will be sent to IIM Bangalore for their area subjects. After completing two years of coursework, students must pass a thorough comprehensive exam before beginning their thesis work. Under the direction of his/her thesis advisor and the thesis advisory committee, the Ph.D. student will frequently spend the next couple of years delving deeply into a particular area of scholarly inquiry. The successful public defense of the doctoral thesis by the doctoral student marks the conclusion of a Ph.D. programme. It is a requirement for all doctoral candidates to get published in prestigious international journals. The institute provides considerable funding for a variety of scholarly activities, including doctoral colloquia, teaching seminars, practicum, participation in international conferences, and presenting high-caliber research papers at these conferences. Additionally, the institute requires all Ph.D. students to successfully participate in and complete a teaching workshop and practicum. The doctorate students are also supported by a fully operational library with cutting-edge resources like journal packages, databases, books, and computing equipment. The programme is entirely residential, and financial assistance in the form of a stipend is given for a maximum of four years.

ADMISSIONS

Candidates must possess one of the following qualifications to apply for IIM Bodh Gaya's doctoral programme: Master's degree in any discipline, with at least 60 percent marks or equivalent grade point average, or Professional qualifications like CA, ICWA, CS with at least 60 percent marks or equivalent grade point average, or Five-year Integrated Master's degree programme in any discipline, with at least 60 percent marks, obtained after completing higher secondary schooling (10+2) or equivalent, or Four Year/Eight Semester Bachelor's Degree in Engineering (B.E./B.Tech./ B. Arch.) with at least 65 percent or equivalent.

The percentage of marks obtained by the candidate would be calculated based on the rule as followed by the respective University/Institution. In absence of such rule, all the subjects on the marksheets should be considered while calculating the passing percentage marks. In case of grades / CGPA, the conversion to percentage of marks would be based on the procedure as certified by the respective University/ institution. If any University/Institution confirms that there is no scheme for converting CGPA into equivalent marks, the equivalence would be established by dividing the candidate's CGPA by the maximum possible CGPA and multiplying the result with 100.

Admission Tests

Candidates who fulfil the eligibility criteria as stated above are required to take Common Admission Test (CAT) held by the IIMs. Alternatively, those who have qualified GATE, GRE, GMAT or JRF (UGC/CSIR/or equivalent) examinations can also apply in the relevant area of specialization. The date of examination for GATE/GRE/GMAT/JRF must be 1st July 2020 or after and its score/result must be valid on or after 1st January 2023. Score of CAT 2020, CAT 2021 and CAT 2022 will be considered. Admission to the programme is open to Indian citizens only.

Exemptions

Candidates who have already passed two year full-time PGP completed in last 5 years from IIMs with minimum 60 percent marks or equivalent are exempted from the test score and can apply directly. It is necessary that candidates applying for exemption from test must attach copies of both side of the grade sheet to ascertain the equivalence between the grading systems of other IIMs, without which, the application for exemption from test will not be considered.
